

Financial Aid

Students typically use the following financial aid resources to cover tuition charges:

Pell--Federal grant ranging from \$200 to \$2,155 per semester for full-time study. Awards are prorated based on enrollment for part-time study.

TAP--NYS Tuition Assistance Program grant ranging from \$250 to \$1,596 (or tuition cost) per semester for full-time study.

APTS--NYS Aid for Part-Time Study grant ranging from \$250 to \$350 per semester for part-time study.

ACG--Academic Competitiveness Grant, open to Federal Pell Grant recipients who are full time, in a degree program, who graduated from a "rigorous high school curriculum" after January 1, 2006. (visit www.studentaid.ed.gov)

Stafford Loan--Federal loan with eligibility determined on need and class status: Freshmen (earning 29 or less credit hours) may be eligible to borrow up to \$3,500; Sophomores (earning 30 or more credit hours) may be eligible to borrow up to \$4,500. Students considered "independent" have an additional \$4,000 eligibility under the unsubsidized portion of the loan.

To use financial aid to cover tuition and fee charges, you must apply for Federal (FAFSA application) financial aid at least 3 weeks prior to having federal aid applied (ex. Pell, Stafford Loan) to your account. New York State aid programs (TAP, APTS) require at least 4 weeks.

All financial aid is tentative until you attend classes -

Financial aid will not pay for classes in which you enroll but do not attend. If you do not plan to attend a class, you must go to Add/Drop to remove the course from your schedule prior to the start of the refund penalty period (see Refund Schedule). Failure to do so places the financial payment responsibility on you. The same is true if you no longer plan to attend any classes at NCCC. (See the WITHDRAWALS/REFUNDS section).

IMPORTANT NOTE: Know your Financial Obligation

Students are responsible for any charges offset by financial aid for which they become ineligible. Accounts with unpaid balances after tuition due date shall be considered in a state of default. All grades and records shall be impounded and ineligibility for any further registration will remain in effect until such time as the financial obligation has been paid. All costs and expenses incurred by the College in the enforcement of collection of past due accounts, including, without limitation, attorney's fees shall be the responsibility of the student.

Payment Plan

Full- and part-time students may choose the following Payment Plan.

1st Payment Due: December 6, 2007 - 25% of outstanding tuition and fees, plus a \$35 one-time, non-refundable administrative fee.

2nd Payment Due: January 3, 2008 - 25% of outstanding tuition and fees.

3rd Payment Due: January 31, 2008 - 25% of outstanding tuition and fees.

4th Payment Due: February 28, 2008 - balance of tuition and fees.

Financial Aid, Scholarships & Grants

Students whose billing reflects financial aid or other scholarship or grant credits must sign and return such bill to the Cashier's Office by the Tuition Due Date to acknowledge that they wish to apply such credits (subject to adjustment) toward their outstanding charges. Failure to do so will cause such credits to not be considered as applied to outstanding charges, potentially putting the student's account in a state of default. Any amounts charged which are not covered by anticipated Financial Aid or other credits, must be paid by the student no later than the Tuition Due Date.

WITHDRAWALS/REFUNDS

The calculation of refunds of tuition and fees will be based on your official withdrawal date in accordance with the College policy and the State University of New York regulations.

Spring 2008 Refund Schedule*

- 100%** for withdrawals processed through Jan. 21, 2008.
- 75%** for withdrawals processed from Jan. 22 through Jan. 28, 2008.
- 50%** for withdrawals processed from Jan. 29 through Feb. 4, 2008.
- 25%** for withdrawals processed from Feb. 5 through Feb. 11, 2008.
- 0%** from Feb. 12, 2008 and beyond.

Spring 2008 LPN Refund Schedule

- 100%** for withdrawals processed through Jan. 3, 2008.
- 75%** for withdrawals processed from Jan. 4 through Jan. 10, 2008.
- 50%** for withdrawals processed from Jan. 11 through Jan. 17, 2008.
- 25%** for withdrawals processed from Jan. 18 through Jan. 24, 2008.
- 0%** from Jan. 25, 2008 and beyond.
