<u>DATE</u>	<u>EVENT</u>	<u>WHAT TO EXPECT & HELPFUL HINTS</u>
December	Purchase Books and Supplies	◆ Bookstore opens prior to the start of classes. See www.niagaracc.bncollege.com for hours & info.
December 19	Begin Online Purchases	◆ Online bookstore orders using Financial Aid for payment begin processing on 12/19/18.
December 19	Begin In-Store Purchases	◆ Return books with receipt for full refund by 01/19/19. Return dropped course books with receipt and proof of schedule change by 02/15/19.
January 2-13	Winter Intersession 2019	◆ Excellent opportunity to make up classes or to reduce course load for future semesters.
January 13	0% Tuition & Fee Liability Period Ends for Spring 2019*	◆ Last day to withdraw from <u>all</u> Spring 2019 classes or reduce class schedule online through Banner Web without a financial obligation. *Module Classes are different. See Registration & Records (A201).
January 14	Access Starfish – Your Academic Success and Support Portal	◆ Log into Blackboard and click on “Starfish Login”. Sign up for Starfish text alerts in your profile and view your personal Success Network to see who is in your corner this semester!
January 14	First Day of Classes-Spring 2019	◆ Excitement, confusion, & anticipation! Having trouble finding parking? – Look for space behind the buildings. (Student parking is in Lots 1, 4, and 5.)
January 14 -17	Add/Drop Days	◆ Use Banner Web for necessary schedule changes or talk with an advisor at an add/drop session. Schedule changes may impact financial liability.
January 14-18	Welcome Week	◆ Join us for a week of activities to welcome new and returning students to campus and to celebrate a new academic year!
January 14 – February 1	CRISIS! Missing Classes During the First Three Weeks	◆ Talk to your instructors, academic advisor, or Student Development (A131)
January 14 – February 1	Attendance Recorded	◆ Faculty must report student attendance – especially during these weeks. Failure to attend class(es) may result in a final grade of a W/withdrawal or X/withdrawal from college. This may also reduce your financial aid and leave you with a bill.
January 15	Grades Posted	◆ Winter Intersession 2019 grades available on Banner Web after 5 pm.
January 21	Martin Luther King Day	◆ College closed.
February 4	Deadline for Deleting Classes*	◆ Last day to drop a course and have it deleted from your schedule – “W” grades given after this day. Financial liability remains. *Module classes are different. See Registration & Records (A201).
February 18	Presidents' Day	◆ College Closed.
February 20	Job & Internship Fair	◆ Sanborn Campus. Dress for success and bring your resume. See the College Website for participating employers.
February 20	Transfer Fair	◆ College representatives on the Sanborn Campus – don't miss it!
February 25- March 4	Academic Deficiency E-Mail Notification	◆ Students in danger of failing a course may receive a warning e-mail from Academic Affairs via Starfish. Follow suggestions given in the e-mail and consult with your instructor(s) and advisor.
March 1	DSS/Statler Scholarship Deadline	◆ Distinguished Student Scholarship deadline for the Fall 2019 semester for incoming Niagara County High School graduates and the Statler Foundation Scholarship for the Spring 2019 semester.

March 5	All Purpose Day	◆ No classes – day or evening.
March 6 & 7	Grad Fair	◆ Prep for graduation. On the Sanborn Campus.
Week of March 8	First Federal Pell/Loan Refunds Issued	◆ Checks will be mailed – is your correct address on file with the Registration & Records Office (A-201)?
March 9-15	Spring Recess	◆ College Closed – Catch-up academically, R & R – Enjoy!
March 18	Advisement & Registration for Summer and Fall 2019 Begins	◆ Register before new students!! Schedule an appointment with your advisor to plan courses and register for next semester. This is mandatory to register – don't miss it!!
March 26	Spring Health Fair	◆ Various agencies on the Sanborn Campus with FREE testing, information and giveaways related to health and wellness. There is something for everyone!
April 1	Financial Aid On-Time Deadline	◆ All students should file a FAFSA by this date to secure funds for Fall classes – don't delay! Applications filed after this date may not show up as processed aid on your bill.
April 3	Job & Internship Fair	◆ NFCI Campus. Dress for success and bring your resume. See the College Website for participating employers.
April 5	Scholarship Deadline (Fall 2019 Awards)	◆ To apply for the many NCCC scholarships available, visit the Scholarship webpage www.niagaracc.suny.edu/scholarships
April 15	Last Day to Withdraw From a Class or Elect an S/U Grade	◆ Decision Day! Should a course be dropped to get a “W” grade or is the course salvageable? See your instructor. Don't wait until the last day! Dropping a course may negatively affect progress toward your degree – talk with your advisor. Dropping a course may also affect your eligibility for Financial Aid – speak to someone in the Financial Aid Office. *Module classes are different. See Registration & Records (A201)
April 15	Last Day to Withdraw From the College	◆ Withdrawing from all classes results in “X” grades and may affect your Financial Aid and academic standing – talk to a Student Development counselor (A131). You may withdraw from the College online through Banner Web or the form is available in Registration & Records (A201). *Module classes are different. See Registration & Records (A201).
April 19	Good Friday	◆ College Closed
April 22	Graduation Application Deadline	◆ Login to Banner Web. Under “Student Records” select “Graduation Application – Submit”. You cannot graduate without completing this application! If you are earning a degree and a certificate or more than one degree, be sure to apply for BOTH!
April 25	Summer Tuition Due	◆ Deadline to pay your bill if you are registered for Summer 2019 courses.
April 26	Thunderfest!	◆ Come to the campus wide event. Thunderfest is a way for the NCCC community to come together and celebrate their NCCC pride by enjoying live entertainment, interactive activities, carnival rides and a huge selection of foods from local vendors. Open to all students and friends of NCCC! Contact Student Life for more information
