



ADVISEMENT PREPARATION



Making sure that you are taking the right classes for your major will save you time and money in the long run, not to mention, it will place you in classes that better suit your interests. But before you go to that advisement meeting – let's make sure you are prepared for it!

1. Although every student has an advisor to assist them with choosing the appropriate classes for their discipline, it is beneficial to attend your advisement appointments with some preparation done beforehand.
