

Niagara Liberty Partnerships Program Volunteer Needs:

-After-school tutoring program runs Monday through Thursday 1:30 pm to 4:00 pm. Students work on-site on their homework, projects, and enrichment activities. Volunteers would assist with homework help on site at one of the schools in Niagara Falls, Lockport, and North Tonawanda

-Workshops and enrichment activities run after-school and can also be set up on weekends (weekend activities have limited transportation). If you have an area of specialization (art, music, sports, technology, etc.) we can set up a one-time lesson or a series of workshops, depending on your project. Materials can be ordered through Liberty at no cost to you.

-Mentoring activities are also encouraged. Volunteers can be matched with one or more students to provide more direct mentoring, taking students to extracurricular trips or events, etc.

-Volunteers are always encouraged to attend and help out with Liberty events. We would provide detailed information of the positions, dates and times when the events occur. Mural project, community garden, video project, etc.
