

NYS Federation of Home Bureau Scholarship in Memory of Agnes Kazmierczak #95

This scholarship was established in 2003 in memory of Agnes Kazmierczak, the past treasurer of this statewide organization.

Amount: Varies

Criteria: 1. Awarded to students enrolled full time in the Criminal Justice curriculum. The alternate field of study is Accounting.
2. Applicant must have and maintain a minimum 2.85 GPA.
3. Applicant must be in the program for at least 1 year (either at NCCC or transferred from elsewhere carrying a minimum of 9 credit hours in addition to work/study or internship.
4. Applicant must be a resident of NYS within an organized county of Home Bureau.
5. Applicant should have experience and have participated in activities for selected field.

Procedure: 1. Complete the NCCC Scholarship Application and the Home Bureau Agnes Kazmierczak #95 application available on the NCCC scholarship webpage.
2. Write an essay demonstrating your financial need and outline your experience and activities in the Criminal Justice or Accounting field and length of time spent on each activity.
3. (Unofficial) transcript showing your most recent GPA.
4. Submit (1) letter of reference from a NCCC faculty member regarding your character and academic ability.
