ATTENTION Fall 2020 Students:

Due to the ongoing COVID pandemic, it is our intention to offer a variety of instructional methods, including blended, hybrid, web and on-campus course offerings in Fall 2020 (see definitions below). Therefore, it may be necessary to adjust the method of instruction currently being offered.

With this in mind, please carefully review your schedule in Banner Web to ensure you are registered for classes in the method of instruction you prefer. You should continue to monitor your schedule for potential changes that may occur.

BLENDED

A Blended course is taught approximately 50% synchronously through web conferencing software such as Zoom and approximately 50% online. The percentages may vary based on the course requirements.

HYBRID

A hybrid course is taught approximately 50% face to face and 50% online. The percentages may vary based on the course requirements.

WEB

A web course is taught 100% online asynchronously. Students are not required to come to campus to participate in the course. Some online courses do require a proctored exam.

We hope to be able to deliver courses in the method of instruction you have chosen, but the pandemic situation may cause modifications in the future. If your course schedule is impacted, you will be notified. Please continue to closely monitor your college email account. 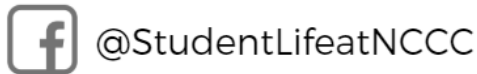
