## Couple of things you need to know when coming to Sanborn and/or NFCI:

Before you come to campus please know the following:

- Entrances for each campus will be limited. Sanborn students will be required to enter at either Learning Commons entrance. NFCI students will be required to enter either the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor garage entrance or the street level entrance on Old Falls Street.
- Each student, faculty and staff member will be asked to complete a COVID Screening. For quicker entry, we recommend that you complete the survey prior to arriving on campus. There will be two lines, express line for those who have done the survey and one line for those who have not. - Everyone entering the campus will be asked to provide their NCCC ID for screening. If you don't have a NCCC ID, please obtain one as soon as possible at the Public Safety Office.

Masks will be required at the Sanborn and NFCI locations. Masks must be worn at all times – in classrooms, laboratories, hallways, computer labs, library, study rooms, Snack Bar (unless eating), etc...

## BANNER:

## Food Service at Sanborn Campus:

We have spent the summer refining our menu and looking at every ingredient used to make sure that each one adds quality to the dish.

- Tim Hortons will be open 7:20 am - 2 pm M-F and 11:30 am - 2:30 pm Sundays and Holidays starting 8/24
- Snack Bar will be open Monday 11:00 am-7pm; Tue-Fri 8:30 am-7 pm, Sat 11:30 am-2:30 pm starting 8/24/2020. The Snack Bar has been re-imaged into a Grab & Go venue with premade sandwiches and salads, as well as your favorite Value Meals, pizza and packaged snacks and beverages. Each day, the snack bar will feature a "Hot Sandwich" and "Hot Dish" of the day. A menu of these can be found on the NCCC website in the Dining Services section.
- There will be no buffet-style service in Dining Services for Fall semester.
- Students are required to wear masks when in line and in the Snack Bar.
- We have installed a new cash register system to speed service and reduce lines.
- New Housing Students-Please take your Student ID card to College Association office G-215 to have the Meal Plan activated before purchasing food.
- All food is prepared following the latest ServSafe Covid guidelines
- All our Dining Services are fully sanitized at close and cleaned throughout the day.
- The most exciting change for 2020 is the reestablishment of our ties with the Niagara Falls Culinary Institute.
  - Throughout the year, we will be phasing in soups, desserts, sauces and other creations of the talented chefs at NFCI.

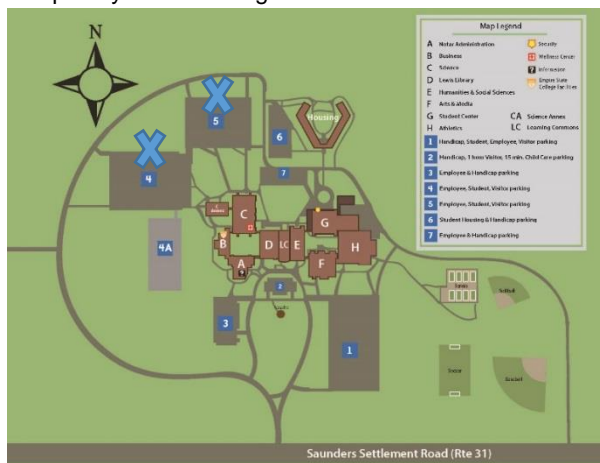

## Parking:

For our NFCI Friends: Two entrances at NFCI – parking ramp – 3<sup>rd</sup> floor and Front entrance on Old Falls Street. If you are driving, please park in the parking ramp and remember to get your parking pass.

For our Sanborn friends who will be driving, we recommend that you park in the back of campus. Lot 1 is being used for testing at this time. Be sure to read the signs and only park in the student designated areas. You will have to enter through Learning Commons to complete your screening.



**Shuttle to NFCI:** Please visit this site <https://www.niagaracc.suny.edu/shuttle/> after 8/30/2020 for the most up-to-date schedule. It also provides a great tracker so you know where the shuttle is at any given time. Masks must be worn while riding the campus shuttle. Maximum capacity for the shuttle is 10 customers; please plan ahead if you are using the shuttle to get to and from classes.
