# **Registration & Records News:**

The last day to drop/delete Fall 2020 courses is **Monday, September 21**. Courses dropped on or before September 21 will not appear on your transcript/schedule.

Students have the following options available to DROP/WITHDRAW from a class:

- 1. Drop online in Banner Web: Click here for detailed instructions (This option will no longer be available for Fall classes starting September 22)
- 2. Complete the Drop or Withdraw from a Course Request Form
- 3. Contact Registration and Records from your T-Wolves email at <a href="mailto:records@niagaracc.suny.edu">records@niagaracc.suny.edu</a>. The email MUST come from your T-Wolves email account.

If you choose to drop a course after the dates listed above, the course will remain on your transcript and a "W" grade will be assigned.

#### NEED TO ORDER AN OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT? Place your order online through **Banner Web**:

- Click on the Student Services and Financial Aid tab
- Choose Student Records
- Order Official Transcript OR
- Go to the Registration & Records webpage and click on the Transcripts Plus logo.

There is a \$10 fee for each official transcript ordered. Please note: unofficial transcripts are free of charge and may be obtained by logging into Banner Web. Click on the Student Services & Financial Aid tab, choose Student Records, Academic Transcript.




