Rapid Testing for COVID-19:

The following sites are currently offering Rapid Testing for COVID-19. The test results are usually available in 15 minutes.

Please Note that rapid tests are recommended only for symptomatic people. The rapid tests are not as sensitive as the PCR tests (nasopharyngeal) so the Erie County Commissioner of Health, Dr. Gale Burstein, states, "People who don't have symptoms should really think twice about spending their money or their time getting a rapid antigen test because if that's negative and you're asymptomatic, I would feel very uncomfortable that is a valid test result."
