## Mandatory Pool Testing:

As a reminder, there will be mandatory pool testing upon your return to campus after the holiday break. If you are online only until February, you need only test in February upon your return. If you never come to either campus and all your courses are on line, you do not have to test. Failure to comply will result in denial of entering into the building, until a negative test is provided. This is a swab saliva test, not a nasal test.

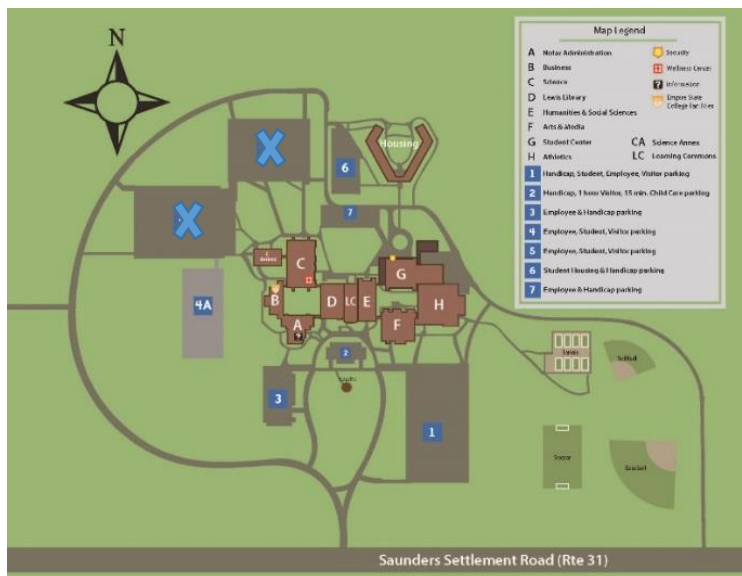

### Sanborn Campus Parking:



For our NCCI Friends: Two entrances at NCCI – parking ramp – 3<sup>rd</sup> floor and Front entrance on Old Falls Street. If you are driving, please park in the parking ramp and remember to get your parking pass.

For our Sanborn friends who will be driving, we recommend that you park in the back of campus (the X on the map above). Lot 1 is being used for NYS testing at this time. Be sure to read the signs and only park in the student-designated areas. You will have to enter through Learning Commons to complete your screening process.

**Shuttle:** Please visit this site <https://www.niagaracc.suny.edu/shuttle/> for the most up-to-date schedule. It also provides a great tracker so you know where the shuttle is at any given time. Masks must be worn while riding the campus shuttle. Maximum capacity for the shuttle is 10 customers; please plan ahead if you are using the shuttle to get to and from classes.

### Lockers:

If you want to rent a locker, you must go to Public Safety. Public Safety on Sanborn is in G-Building and Public Safety at NCCI is at the Front Desk area.

### NCCC Dining Services:

There will be limited services beginning January 19, 2021. Dining Services offers the students of NCCC a wide variety of meal and snack options to please even the most discriminating palette:

**Tim Hortons**, located in the North end of the Learning Commons, presents WNY's favorite breakfast menu along with coffee, teas and blended drinks complimented by fresh bagels, muffins and donuts. Open Mon-Fri 7:30am-2:00pm and Sundays 10:30am-2:30pm.

**Our Snack Bar**, located on the first floor of G Building, is open Mon-Fri 8:30am-7:00pm and Saturdays 10:30am-2:30pm. This main dining hall offers a wide assortment of freshly cracked breakfast choices in the morning, followed by an extensive array of subs, sandwiches, nachos, tacos, burgers, pizza, baked goods, drinks, fresh baked goods, desserts and snack items.
