Mandatory Pool Testing:

As a reminder, there will be mandatory pool testing for all those students that come to campus. If you are online only until February, you need only test in February upon your return. If you never come to either campus and all your courses are on line, you do not have to test at all. Failure to comply will result in denial of entering into the building, until a negative test is provided. This is a swab saliva test, not a nasal test.

The test location on the Sanborn Campus is in the Learning Commons in the Art Gallery. Please preregister at www.suny-covid-test.com. As of today, the following are the dates and times when the pool testing will be performed at the Sanborn Campus:

Monday-8am to 3pm Tuesday-8:30am to 3:30pm Wednesday-10am to 6pm Thursday- 8:30am to 3:30pm Friday-8am to 3pm


