Summer & Fall 2021 Current Student Registration Begins TODAY - March 22<sup>nd</sup>!

Registration for students currently enrolled in the Spring 2021 term AND in a degree and/or certificate program starts TODAY, March 22<sup>nd</sup>. **Detailed information about current student registration was sent to your T-Wolves Email.
