Summer & Fall 2021 Current Student Registration Begins March 22nd!

Registration for students currently enrolled in the Spring 2021 term AND in a degree and/or certificate program starts on Monday, March 22nd. Detailed information about current student registration was sent to your T-Wolves Email. Please read your email for the date and time you are eligible to register for classes in Banner Web or check your Registration Eligibility at the top of your degree evaluation in Degree Works.
