Spring 2021 Graduation Application Deadline:

The deadline to file for May graduation is **April 30th**. **If you plan to earn more than one degree and/or certificate in the Spring semester, please submit a graduation application for both.**

- Apply through Banner Web:
 - Click on “Student Records”
 - Click on “Apply for Graduation”
 - Select the major you are applying for. If you do not see your major listed, please contact the Registration & Records Office at 716-614-6250.
 - Indicate if you plan to attend Commencement and select how you would like your name to appear on your diploma.
 - Verify the information you entered is correct and click “Submit Request”
 - You can view your submitted application under the Student Records tab of Banner Web at any time.

Last Day to Submit Information for Virtual Commencement!

TODAY, Monday, April 26th is the final day that graduates can submit their picture and information to be included in the [Virtual Commencement Ceremony](#) that will be streamed on Friday, May 7th at 7pm.
