As a reminder per the SUNY mandate, there will be **weekly mandatory COVID testing** for all those students that come to campus until further notice. Failure to comply will result in denial of entering into the building, until a negative test is provided. This is a swab saliva test, not a nasal test. New York State continues to expand vaccine eligibility. Now, you can get a vaccine if:

- ✓ You're 30 years of age or older
- ✓ You're an in-person college staff member

As you know, New York State is currently working to distribute vaccines to all eligible New Yorkers, with many SUNY campuses serving as vaccine distribution sites. With the recent expansion of criteria for appointment eligibility, all New Yorkers age 30 and above, as well as all in-person college staff, are now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccines.
