Mandatory Testing:

There will be mandatory weekly COVID testing if you are on campus for your classes or use the facilities. If you never come to either campus and all your courses are on line, you do not have to test. Failure to comply will result in denial of entering the buildings, until a negative test is provided. This is a swab saliva test, not a nasal test.

The test location on the Sanborn Campus is in the Learning Commons in the Art Gallery. NFCI is in the Theatre. Please preregister at www.suny-covid-test.com The following are the times when the pool testing will be performed:

Sanborn 9 am – 3 pm Monday-Thursday
NFCI 10 am – 4 pm Wednesday and Thursday

Campus Pantry Information:

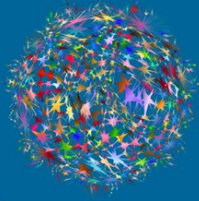
