COVID Screening:

The College has recently added a new screening question that needs to be answered upon entry into the campus. The question is "Are you fully vaccinated against COVID-19?" The individual would simply answer Yes or No to that question, no other information should be provided. If the individual answers Yes to that question, they will not have to answer that question again. The answer is kept confidential and is stored in our secure database.

This question is being asked of our employees and students so the college has knowledge of the percentage of our campus community that is fully vaccinated so that we can make appropriate determinations in the future in regards to the level of capacity on campus for classes, meetings, and events to ensure everyone's safety.

If you are uncomfortable verbally providing this information to the screener, then you should fill out the COVID-19 Screening Survey online in Banner prior to entering the campus which can be found here: https://nccbanner.itec.suny.edu/PROD/zcv19surv.P_SubmitRequest

Also, if you are uncomfortable providing your phone number, date of birth, and/or ID# to the screener, please make sure that you have your NCCC ID badge with you so that you can scan your badge at the screening station instead. If you have lost your ID card, please go to the Public Safety Office located in G-106 of the Sanborn campus and at the Reception desk of the NCCI campus
