As a reminder, the NCCC Commencement Ceremony will be held on Saturday, May 14 at 10:00 a.m. in the Main Gym on the Sanborn Campus. On the day of the ceremony, graduates are asked to arrive at 9:00 a.m. and report to the Arts and Media Theatre in F. Building. Please note that caps & gowns must be purchased at the Barnes and Noble bookstore in Sanborn or at NFCI by Wednesday, May 4 in order to participate. Two tickets will be provided to each graduate registered for the ceremony. Ticket pick-up is from Thursday, May 5 – Friday, May 13 in the Barnes and Noble location where you purchased your cap & gown. Tickets not picked up by Friday, May 13 will be forfeited. 
Seasonal Help needed:
