NCCC STUDENT MEAL PLAN

Students who reside in Student Housing Village will be required to choose at least to 80 meal plan. The cost of the meal plan will be over and above the room rate selected within housing. The money paid by the student will be accessed through the Student ID (swipe card) within any of the food service establishments at Niagara County Community College. Any unused meal swipes would be forfeited at the end of each academic year.

<u>Meal Contents:</u> One entrée, one side, and one beverage. This may also include single grab and go prepared meals, which can be taken back to the student's residence and be heated.

NTripp Dollars can be used at any of the food service establishments at Niagara County Community College for ala carte items at any time during the semester. NTripp Dollars can be replenished through adding monies to the student's account throughout the academic semester, in the College Association Office, G-215.

36 meals (approximately 2 meals per week and \$30 NTripp Dollars).	\$375 per semester
48 meals (approximately 3 meals per week and \$50 NTripp Dollars).	\$510 per semester
80 meals (Minimum for Housing Students) (approximately 5 meals per week and \$50 NTripp Dollars).	\$780 per semester
112 meals (one meal per day per week – 7 meals per week and \$50 NTripp Dollars)	\$1,070 per semester
160 meals (approximately two meals per weekday per week and \$100 NTripp Dollars)	\$1,530 per semester
224 meals (approximately two meals per day – 14 meals per week and \$100 NTripp Dollars)	\$2,030 per semester
240 meals (approximately three meals per weekday per week and \$150 NTripp Dollars)	\$2,210 per semester
