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****Important:** Please read the policies and procedures below to determine your financial aid eligibility for the Winter Mini session

A. Requirements:

- Student **must** be matriculated in a degree program at Niagara County Community College **prior** to the 2023 Winter Mini session.

Student must meet satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements at the end of the Fall 2022 semester. If the Financial Aid Office determines a student is not making satisfactory academic progress (SAP) after the Fall 2022 semester, students will be responsible for any winter charges.

- Students must be registered for **both** the Winter Mini **and** Spring 2023 semesters. Winter mini session classes will be added to your Spring 2023 semester but you will have a separate bill for the winter session classes.
- Students must have a valid 2022-2023 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) on file prior to December 20, 2022.
- The Federal Pell Grant will be available to only those students who qualify for additional Pell Grant eligibility. Check with Financial Aid Office to see if you qualify for additional PELL funds.

B. Financial Aid:

- There will be **NO** disbursements or refunds issued for the Winter Mini session. Even though your winter classes will be added to your spring schedule, financial aid will be paid as follows for the spring semester:

TAP – You must be registered full time in the spring semester. Winter classes do not count.

APTS – You must be registered for at least 6 credit hours for the spring semester. Winter classes do not count.

LOANS - You must be registered for at least 6 credit hours for the spring semester. Winter classes do not count.

PELL – Your winter classes will be counted in your spring enrollment and your PELL grant will be based on both semester classes added together.

You must pass your winter classes to receive an increased PELL payment if not full time for the spring semester.
