FINANCIAL AID FOR THE 2023 WINTER TERM

Financial Aid is not available for the Winter Intersession. However, Winter 2023 term students who are also attending the Spring 2023 term may be able to defer Winter term charges by using Spring Federal Financial Aid. Contact Financial Aid at (716) 614-6266 for more information.

Students with financial aid, scholarships or grant awards must E-sign their Financial Responsibility Agreement to acknowledge that they wish to apply such credits toward their account balance. Failure to E-sign puts your financial aid at risk. The form is available through Banner Web, under Student & Financial Aid.

All financial aid is tentative!

Financial aid will not pay for classes you do not attend. If you do not plan to attend a class, you must login to Banner Web and go to Add/Drop classes to remove course(s) from your schedule prior to the start of the term (see Refund Schedule). Failure to do so places the financial payment responsibility on you. If you no longer plan to attend any classes at NCCC, see the HOW TO WITHDRAW FROM THE COLLEGE section.

KNOW YOUR FINANCIAL OBLIGATION

All tuition and fees incurred as a result of course registration or other student activity are due and payable to NCCC, and are the student's responsibility to pay. Financial aid that appears on an account is only an estimate until earned. Financial aid eligibility changes because of non-attendance, insufficient academic progress and ineligible courses. Accounts with unpaid balances after final payment plan due date will be considered delinquent and a hold will be placed on the account. Holds prevent a student from registering for future classes and receiving diplomas and certificates. NCCC may refer delinquent accounts to an outside collection agency for further collection efforts. Student is responsible for paying the collection agency fee, which may be based on a percentage at a maximum of 33.3333% of the delinquent account, together with all costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, NCCC incurs in such collection efforts. Student's failure to pay financial obligation may be reported to credit bureaus, which will negatively impact the student's credit score.

PAYMENT POLICY
