

FINANCIAL AID FOR THE 2023 SUMMER TERM

To use financial aid for tuition and fee charges, you must apply for Federal financial aid (FAFSA application) at least 3 weeks prior to payment due date to ensure federal aid is applied to your account. New York State aid programs require additional processing time.

Students with financial aid, scholarships or grant awards must E-sign their Financial Obligation Agreement to acknowledge that they wish to apply such credits towards the account balance. Failure to E-sign puts your financial aid at risk. The form is available through Banner Web, under Student & Financial Aid.

All financial aid is tentative!

Financial aid will not pay for classes you do not attend. If you do not plan to attend a class, you must login to Banner Web and go to Add/Drop classes to remove course(s) from your schedule prior to the start of the liability period (see Refund Schedule). Failure to do so places the financial payment responsibility on you. If you no longer plan to attend any classes at NCCC, see the HOW TO WITHDRAW FROM THE COLLEGE section.

KNOW YOUR FINANCIAL OBLIGATION

All tuition and fees incurred as a result of course registration or other student activity are due and payable to NCCC, and are the student's responsibility to pay. Financial aid that appears on an account is only an estimate until earned. Financial aid eligibility changes because of non-attendance, insufficient academic progress and ineligible courses. Accounts with unpaid balances after final payment plan due date will be considered delinquent and a hold will be placed on the account. Holds prevent a student from registering for future classes, access to grades, and receiving diplomas and certificates. NCCC may refer delinquent accounts to an outside collection agency for further collection efforts. Student is responsible for paying the collection agency fee, which may be based on a percentage at a maximum of 33.3333% of the delinquent account, together with all costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, NCCC incurs in such collection efforts. Student's failure to pay financial obligation may be reported to credit bureaus, which will negatively impact the student's credit score.

PAYMENT PLAN OPTIONS:

If you are unable to pay your student account balance in full by the payment due date or at time of registration, you may opt to spread the payments over time by enrolling in one of our payment plans - available to both full-time and part-time students.

PAYMENT PLAN INSTALLMENT SCHEDULES

5/4/2023 – first portion* of outstanding tuition and fees, plus \$40 non-refundable fee

6/1/2023 – second portion* due

6/29/2023 – third portion or balance of account is due

7/27/2023 – fourth/final portion is due

*Note: installment amounts are based on the plan you selected:

3-Pay 33%/33%/balance, OR

4-Pay 25%/25%/25%/balance

NEW: Payment Plan Forms are electronic only. You will find a link to the form on our website's Tuition & Fees Forms page. There are also links within Banner Web, under Student Accounts. The Dynamic Form's design is user friendly for a variety of devices.

PAYMENT POLICY

NCCC requires all students to pay full account balance by the payment due date or enroll in our payment plan. If you enroll in classes after the payment due date, payment in full is due at the time of registration. If your account balance is not paid in full any time after the payment due date, or you are not enrolled in a payment plan, your course schedule **may** be dropped.

PAY IN FULL OPTIONS:

1. Online: Pay by credit or debit card, via Banner Web. We accept Visa, Mastercard and Discover Cards.
2. In-person: Pay by credit card, debit card, cash, personal check, money order, or cashier's check at the Cashier's Office, Room A205.
3. Financial Aid.

Refunds of tuition and fees will be based on your official withdrawal date in accordance with College policy and State University of New York regulations.

Note: Module classes have varying refund dates. For complete refund schedule go to www.niagaracc.suny.edu, MYNCCC >> Banner Web >> Refund Schedule. After the term begins, dropping your last class (or only class) will require NCCC staff assistance. Also, various holds that can be applied to student accounts can PREVENT you from dropping a class without staff assistance, even if the term has not yet begun.

How to Withdraw From the College:

If you register for courses and decide not to attend, you **MUST** officially withdraw from NCCC. Non-attendance and/or non-payment will not constitute withdrawal from class(es) and refunds will not apply. To obtain a full refund, you **MUST** withdraw prior to the first day of liability (see above refund schedule).

Before you file a withdrawal form we strongly encourage you to speak with an Academic Coach in the Student Resource Center (A144) to explore options and receive important information.
